NINIAN JOHN BANNATYNE. (IAN).

Lieut. Acting Capt. The King's Liverpool Regt.
Officially reported wounded and missing on
Morning of 3d May. 1917.

Was wounded in the shoulder, and was last seen
cheering on his men against a counter-attack
of the Germans about 5 a.m. at or near
on the sunken road.

Age. 21 years.

Height. About 5ft. 8ins. Rather slight, and thin.
Complexion. Good, medium colour, neither bright-
coloured nor sallow.

Features. Good, rather long shaped head & chin,
Nose rather prominent, mouth small,
Teeth regular, good. Clean-shaven.

Hair, Dark brown.

Eyes, Grey blue.

Neck, Rather thin and long.

He would probably have an Ingersoll watch on
him, and generally carried a small book in his
pocket, a Shakespeare play, or some such work.
He went into action with his neck in bandages.

His Regimental Badge is a horse
with "The King's" on a scroll underneath.
The Badge will be on Cap, Collar, & Buttons.
Probably has three stars on his cuffs.

It is thought very probable that he is a prisoner of war in
Germany.
